In this case, the email came from a compromised @uwo.ca student account, which would have added an air of legitimacy to the email, but clicking on the link would have infected your computer.

The lesson here is that spammers and their bots are getting better at finding ways to fool you into thinking that new email in your inbox is "real". (Even if like so many others, they don't know the difference between UWO and the USC!) In turn, we need to get better at questioning pretty much every email with an attachment or embedded link!
